The first rector of this church of whom there is a record (his name was Hervens) was instituted between 1152 and 1184, and it will be a matter of interest to all, and perhaps of surprise to many, to know that the Poet Crabbe was Rector of Evershot from 1783 to 1786. In conclusion it may be desirable to mention what has been done for this church...
