Quinn Jones, Sr. The book covers his formative, high school and college years. He furthered his education by completing summer courses and earned advanced degrees. The obstacles and challenges he faced, growing up and as a working professional, during the segregation era in the South are disclosed. Specifically he outlined the development of the curriculum of Lincoln High School (Gainesville, Florida) which culminated in the school being the second African-American school to be fully accredited in Florida. This allowed students to officially earn a diploma. His combined positions of teacher and principal reinforced a dual perspective of dealing with unacceptable working conditions in which teachers lacked basic teaching tools and how he organized fundraising drives. He experienced recruiting problems of finding and hiring qualified teachers. Included are special treats of vintage, one-of-a-kind photos, awards, citations, commencement programs and special programs honoring his contributions to the Gainesville and Alachua County communities. As a tribute to his outstanding contributions to the community, A. Quinn Jones Elementary School (currently the A. Quinn Jones Center) was named in his honor. Until his death in 1997 at the age of 104, he was the oldest living graduate...
